Enable Mississippi River Transmission, LLC ("MRT") pursuant to Section 34 of the General Terms and Conditions of its FERC Gas Tariff, Seventh Revised Volume No.1 ("Tariff"), and Section 154.502 of the Commission's Regulations, herewith respectfully submits for filing its Annual Report of Penalty Revenue Credits ("Report"), covering such activity during the twelve-month reporting period ending July 31, 2022 ("Accrual Period").

STATEMENT OF NATURE, REASONS AND BASIS

Section 34 of the General Terms and Conditions ("GT&C") requires MRT to credit to eligible firm customers penalty revenues collected during the Penalty Base Period (August 1, 2021 through July 31, 2022) and that notice of such refunds be provided to the eligible customers on or before November 1 of each year. Pursuant to Section 34 of the GT&C, MRT will not calculate revenue credits if the total Penalty Crediting Revenues do not exceed \$250,000. For the Penalty Base Period ended July 31, 2022, MRT's penalty revenues total was \$148,719.58. Accordingly, this amount, plus interest calculated in accordance with Section 154.501 of the Commission's Regulations, will be carried forward to the next Penalty Base Period.

Section 34 of the GT&C requires that MRT notify Customers of applicable credit amounts for the preceding Penalty Base Period on or before November 1 of each year. As explained above, the penalty revenues collected during the Penalty Base Period will be carried forward to the next Penalty Base Period, so there were no credit amounts for Customers. This filing is being posted on MRT's web site as required by Section 154.502(d) of the Commission's Regulations.
