In accordance with Part 154.602 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's (Commission) Regulations and eTariff cancellation mechanism, Enable Mississippi River Transmission, LLC (MRT) submits for filing the following parent tariff record in order to cancel its FERC Gas Tariff, Tariff Database, which includes its Sixth Revised Volume No. 1 and Second Revised Volume Negotiated Rates and Non-Conforming Agreements, effective August 19, 2022.

STATEMENT OF NATURE, REASONS, AND BASIS

Today MRT filed its Seventh Revised Volume No. 1 which supersedes its Sixth Revised Volume No. 1 in its entirety as well as its Third Revised Volume Filed Agreements which supersedes its Second Revised Volume Negotiated Rates and Non-Conforming Agreements in its entirety. MRT herein requests cancellation of its Tariff Database which includes its Sixth Revised Volume No. 1 and Second Revised Volume Negotiated Rates and Non-Conforming Agreements.

IMPLEMENTATION AND WAIVER REQUEST

Pursuant to Section 154.7(a)(9) of the Commission's Regulations, MRT requests that the Commission make this tariff cancellation effective August 19, 2022, which is the same date that MRT's Seventh Revised Volume No. 1 and Third Revised Volume Filed Agreements are proposed to become effective in MRT's concurrent filings¹. MRT respectfully requests that the Commission grant any waivers that may be necessary to allow the tariff cancellation to become effective on August 19, 2022, as requested.
