Dear Ms. Bose:

Pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 154.203 (2020), Enable Mississippi River Transmission, LLC (“MRT”) respectfully files the following tariff records in compliance with, and to implement the terms of, an April 28, 2020 implementation filing and Commission orders of May 27 and May 29, 2020 accepting the April 28 filing, related to the rates for service under MRT’s Small Customer Transportation Service (“SCT”) Rate Schedule:

Sheet No. 9, Small Customer Transportation Service Rates 20.0.0

MRT’s Docket No. RP20-131 general base rate increase (the “RP20-131 Rate Case”) was completely resolved by settlements filed in November and December 2019 (which were assigned a new docket number, Docket No. RP20-212). Under the Docket No. RP20-212 settlements, the participants agreed to increases in SCT rates that were to take effect January 1, 2022. Article X of the November 2019 settlement specifies that implementing filings can be given effect “without further notice or suspension . . .” and “granting any waiver of Part 154 of the Commission’s regulations necessary to implement such tariff records . . .”<sup>1</sup> The Commission by order of March 26, 2020 approved the settlements and directed MRT to file actual tariff records. *See* Ordering Para. (B).

In its April 28, 2020 implementation filing in Docket Nos. RP18-923, RP20-131 and RP20-212 (“April 28 Filing”),<sup>2</sup> MRT offered, *inter alia*, *pro forma* tariff records concerning SCT rate adjustments to take effect January 1, 2022. The April 28 Filing was uncontested; it was subsequently accepted by letter orders.<sup>3</sup> The attached live tariff records implement increased SCT rates, consistent with the *pro forma* sheets appended to the April 28 Filing that were accepted in the Commission’s May 27, 2020 and May 29, 2020 Orders.

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MRT respectfully requests waiver of Rule 203(b)(3) to allow the following persons to be designated for service in accordance with 18 C.F.R. § 154.7(a)(2).

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MRT respectfully requests that the attached tariff provisions be accepted, following a notice period and without suspension, to take effect on January 1, 2022.<sup>4</sup> In accordance with the Settlement Order, Ordering Paragraph (B), and 18 C.F.R. § 154.7(a)(1), MRT submits in a zip (compressed) file an eTariff XML filing package containing this transmittal letter, the proposed effective date, references to relevant authorities, and a list of tariff sections enclosed. The undersigned, having full power and authority to execute this filing, states that (i) she has read this filing and knows its contents, (ii) the contents are true to the best of her knowledge and belief and (iii) paper copies and the electronic media contain the same information.
